Passage: Matthew 16:13-17, 21-27

Principle: The cost of following Jesus is denying oneself, and following Him.

Praise: "Change My Heart O God"

Prompt: Ask your child these questions:

- What did the Father reveal to Peter?
- What does it mean to die to yourself, pick up your cross and follow Christ?

Practice: Help your child apply these truths by encouraging him or her to:

- Deny himself/herself, take up his/her cross, and follow Christ.
- Praise God that He will one day return and reward those who faithfully followed Him.

John and Lydia remain active at Grace Mission in Anyigba, Kogi State, Nigeria. With the pandemic, their elementary and junior high schools had to temporarily close from March to September, but they have thankfully been able to reopen this past fall. They seek prayer for the school's work, their local gospel tract publication ministry, and outdoor evangelism of the community and Kogi State University. They face continued pressure from taxes that threaten to close local churches, from corrupt government and security teams, from Muslim persecution of new converts, and from threats to the mission.
