Missions Corner

Friendship House (FH) is a Christ-centered local ministry where needs are regularly met for food, housing, and after school care. Last year they distributed 4,526 boxes of food to over 500 families and provided housing and furnishings for two refugee families. An after-school program offers assistance with schoolwork, playtime, snacks, and a Bible lesson for impoverished kids. FH is seeing three times as many families coming to the food pantry this year as Covid economic effects continue. And more Spanish-speaking families are coming now for food assistance and tutoring help. With increased demands in the community they serve, upkeep of the property is more important than ever. The current roof is leaky and in desperate need of replacement at a cost of \$15,000 to \$20,000. Please consider giving on March 10th during the *Roanoke Gives* event to support this important ministry as well as praying for their needs to be met as they grow in their reach into the community.
