

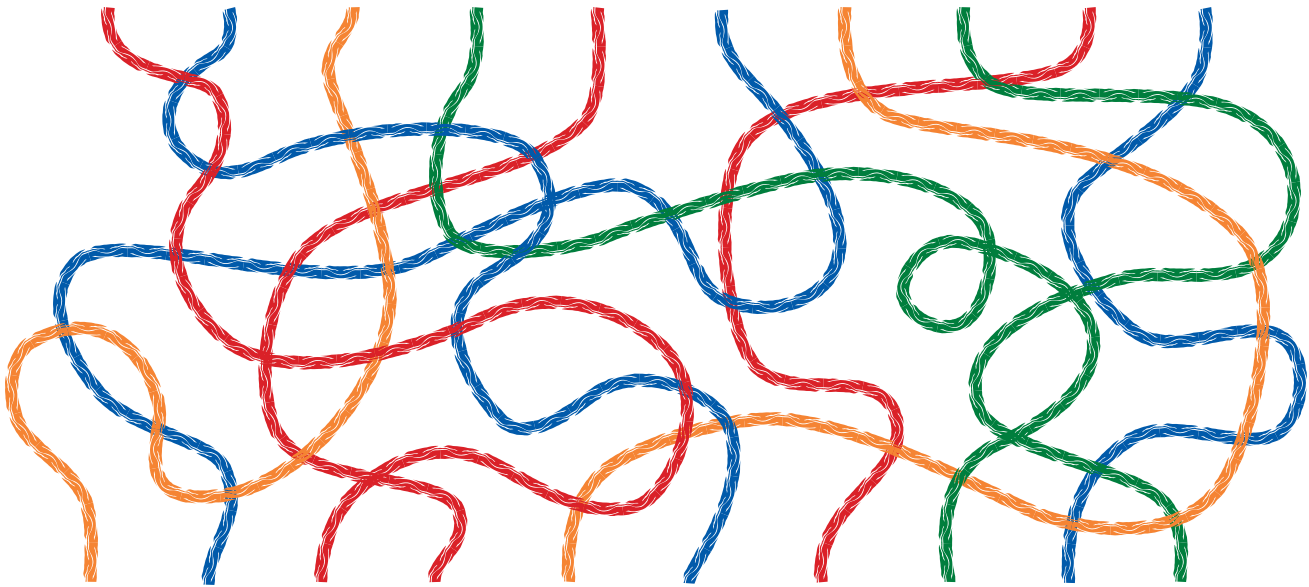


# Weaver



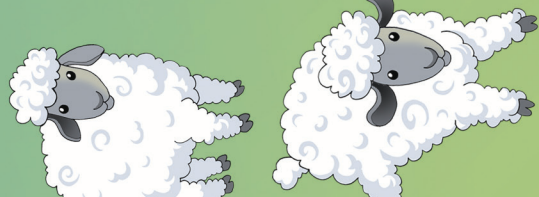
