Jesus invites people to believe in Him and to receive living water (the Holy Spirit).

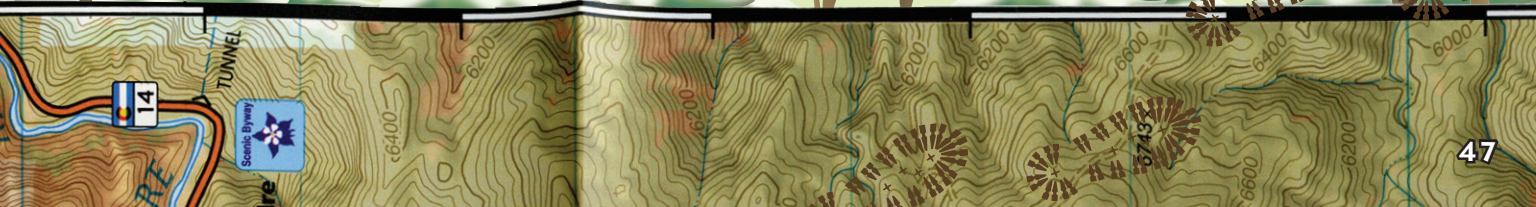
