ACT:

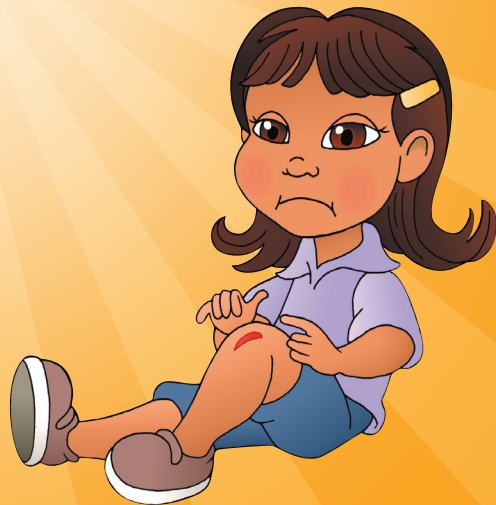
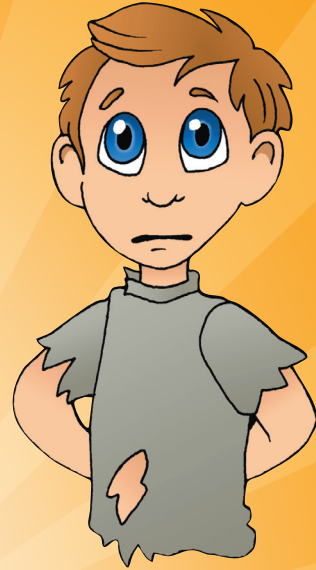
- Read the Bible story together (or read the summary on the front of this page).
