

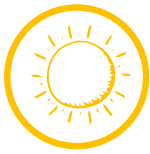



AT HOME

BIBLE PASSAGE: God's Covenant with David/ 2 Samuel 6-7

BIG PICTURE QUESTION: How is Jesus the perfect King? Jesus perfectly rules over the universe as the King of kings.

MEMORY VERSE: Psalm 145:13 "Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom; your rule is for all generations. The Lord is faithful in all his words and gracious in all his actions."



MORNING TIME

ACTIVITY: Read in a tent!

Set up a tent using blankets and chairs. You can review the Bible story inside the tent and then give kids some reading and playtime inside.

Explain: The ark of God lived inside the tabernacle which was a tent! David wanted to build a temple for God but God didn't want it. Instead, God promised to make David's family kings. Jesus came through David's family.



TRAVEL TIME

PRAYER ACTIVITY: You can pray anytime, even in the car!

- *Ask kids why God deserves praise and honor. Tell Him in prayer.
 - *Talk about sins. Confess them to God in prayer and ask for forgiveness.
 - *Name all the things to be thankful for. Give thanks to God in prayer.
 - *Talk about who needs God's help...those sick, in trouble, need encouragement, salvation, specific needs for friends and family, our country. Ask God for His help in prayer.
- You can drive...let your kids pray!
