## **Get To Know You Question:**

Explain a time when you felt God prompting you to do something that made you uncomfortable or you struggled with in your mind.

## **Let's Dig Deeper:**

- Read **John 11:40** – Explain what you think God's glory means in this verse?
- What are the differences between the glory of His presence and the glory of His power? Explain the difference between the two.
- Jesus did not just come to make us better in the natural, He came to make us conduits/channels for the supernatural. Discuss what you understand by this?
  - Can you share a time where you have seen God do the supernatural?
  - Can you share a time where God did something supernatural through you?
- How can you be a conduit for God's glory in your everyday life? Discuss.
- The road to glory does not always feel so good. Discuss some of the challenges and fears you might encounter in your attempt to obey God.
- If the road to glory doesn't always feel so good, why bother go down that road? What are some ways you can keep from shrinking back from it?
- Have you in the last five weeks, wrestles over these questions:
  - When was the last time I was overwhelmed by the glory of God?
  - When was the last time I was terrified of taken another step without God's glory?
  - When was the last time I begged for God's glory to be revealed?
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- If you wrestled over them, what was God saying to you? Share.
- If you have not wrestled over them, why not? Share.

**Prayer as a group:**

1. To continue to experience the glory of God's presence
2. For an increased thirst and longing to see the glory of God's power.
3. For God to use us as channels through which His glory manifests to others
4. For God's grace to walk the road to glory in spite of feelings of fear and embarrassment.
