*Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth.* Colossians 3:2 (NKJV)

*In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.* John 16:33 (NKJV) Oh, God, I am grateful I serve the Living God who has overcome the world.

*Yet in all these things, we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.* Romans 8:37 (NKJV) I am more than a conqueror in You. I believe this.
