
We went from not being welcome in our local school district 28 years ago, to now seeing our ministry's name stitched into our ROCORI Sports Stadium field.

& RIVER YOUTH





RIVER KIDS

River Kids is an exciting and essential ministry in the spiritual foundation of the next generation. River Kids provides a fun, safe, and welcoming environment for kids to grow in their faith in God as a community. Age appropriate worship, lessons, applications and more are all geared towards each child's individual learning styles and stages of developmental growth.

In the last twelve months 229 kids have attended two or more times on a given Wednesday night service. There have also been 295 kids who have attended Sunday morning services two or more times, in the last twelve months.








AT WHAT AGE DID YOU ACCEPT CHRIST?

In the 4 years prior to our Phase 3 building addition, River of Life's attendance growth averaged 4.25%.

In the immediate 12 months following the opening of the building, the attendance growth was 19.21%

Our average weekly online viewing is 320 people. This makes up roughly 35% of our average attendance of inperson and online attendees combined for 2021.

OUR PLAN PHASE IV




The next building addition is the construction of a sanctuary to the south of the current structure.

The plan for this building is to create a space for worship services with the potential for being a multi-purpose room to be able to host banquets and other activities.

Seating capacity would approximate 700-900 seats with some diverse seating options available throughout.

Updated broadcasting. audio, and visual tech would all be installed.



COST

The approximate cost of this project is roughly \$7 million dollars which includes construction, materials, and labor.

CAMPAIGN

The goal is to present the project to the congregation in fall of 2021 with a potential pledge date in November.

CONSTRUCTION

Based on the pledges from the campaign, construction would be in the spring/summer of 2022. The process will be 16 to 19 months.


