
Marvin graduated from Baxter Institute in Honduras in 2002. He and Gisela then spent 9 years as missionaries in Bogota, Columbia, planting a new church there. They returned to their home in Guatemala for 5 years where they worked with the church of Christ in Santa Lucia Milpas Altas, before answering the invitation of Manuel & Nancy Gonzalez, and the Legacy and Burleson churches, to join the work at Siempre Familia.

In June of 2021 their visas in the U.S. will expire and they are planning to return to their home and ministry in Santa Lucia Milpas Atlas.

We praise the Lord as He continues to bless the work at Siempre Familia. This is our greatest joy. We have been praying about what the Lord wants us to do as a church, and our vision for the next 5 years is that we continue growing into a vibrant, self-supporting church serving the Hispanic community in south Fort Worth.

During 2020, Marvin was instrumental in taking SF's services on-line. They returned to in-person worship in September, but continue to stream their services for those who can't attend at their building. Their services have also been a blessing to Spanish-speaking churches in Central America who don't have the tech resources to go on-line. A message from a sister in Guatemala, "Thank you for streaming your services. My church is not meeting and they are not doing on-line services. Being able to connect with you is a blessing for me."

Gisela also saw a need for on-line Bible studies with young girls in Latin America. Working with two sisters in Columbia, they hosted a two day Zoom conference with more than 60 girls from several different nations.



To stay connected with their community and church family, SF has hosted several drive-through food distribution and prayer events, as well as leadership training and a return to services at their building. They are having visitors to their services each week and have had two baptisms.

I thank God for the Legacy Church, because He has used you to bless our lives as we could never imagine before. May God bless you for many years more until He returns.
