3-Feb	Mark Hooper, Missions Resource Network, Asia	Pray for inside leaders: Pares Haldar, Prashanth Alam, and Joel Madiki who are working in Southeast Asia among Hindus and Buddhists to make disciple makers who will begin churches of disciples of Jesus. Pray for outside leaders: Kyle & Rebecca Hooper and Jace & Rebekah Allen in Cambodia. Pray for more inside and outside leaders for Southwest Asia.
