Baptism



Why should I be baptized?

Look up the following verses in your Bible: Matthew 28:19 & Acts 2:38, 41

The first verse shows us that Jesus commands us to be baptized. The second verses teach that we learned this practice from the early church.

What is the meaning of baptism?

Another verse to look up: Check out Romans 6:3-4

Baptism is a signal to others that we have chosen to follow Jesus. It shows that we are giving up control of our lives ("dying" to ourselves) and handing it over to Him.

Does baptism "wash away" my sins?

Read Ephesians 2:8-9

The only one who can "wash away" your sins is Jesus! And he does that when we ask Him to be in charge of our life ("get saved").

Some good reasons we get baptized are:

- 1. It reminds us and others that we are followers of Jesus.
- 2. Sometimes when we tell our story of becoming Christians, others will want to do the same.
- 3. During hard times we can look back on our baptism and remember the commitment we made to follow Jesus.




Telling Your Story
