Scholarship Guidelines for 2022

1. Scholarships will be limited to the lesser of 50% of the cost of the trip or \$1,000.

Examples: If a trip costs \$1,800, max scholarship is \$900.

If a trip costs \$2,400, max scholarship is \$1,000.

2. No team member shall receive more than \$1,000 in scholarships per year.

(Year being defined as Jan. 1 – Dec. 31)

Example: A youth might receive \$125 for the Dallas trip.

Any other trip the youth takes would have a scholarship cap of \$875.

- 3. To receive a scholarship, this application must be filled out by the team member and given to the Mission Council by the Team Leader. This includes chaperones. All recipients must be members of Nettleton Baptist Church.
- 4. Team Leaders will present a trip description and fee breakdown to the Mission Council in writing using the form provided.
- 5. Team Leaders will make every effort to keep trip costs low and encourage team members to evaluate their need for a scholarship before applying. Non-missions related expenses are not eligible for scholarship funds (such as recreational and leisure activities).
