


### TIMELINE OF END TIME EVENTS



# LETTERS TO THE SEVEN CHURCHES (REV. 2-3)

- LITERAL in existence Each church was an actual church located in Turkey during the 1<sup>st</sup> century!
- SPIRITUAL in relevance Each church addresses spiritual issues relevant to churches today!
- HISTORICAL in significance each church represents a distinct time period of church history...

#### EPHESUS-THE APOSTOLIC CHURCH (33-100 A.D.)

- A.D. 33 Pentecost
- A.D. 100 the death of John (end of Apostolic Age; end of the first century church)

## EPHESUS THE APOSTOLIC CHURCH (33-100 A.D.)

<u>JESUS' TITLE:</u> "Him who holds the seven stars in his right hand, who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands"

<u>COMMENDATION:</u> Hardworking; persevering; discerning of false doctrine (the Nicolaitans)

**COMPLAINT:** Left their first love

**REWARD:** To eat from the tree of life in the paradise of God

#### SMYRNA - THE SUFFERING CHURCH (100-312 A.D.)

- A.D. 100 end of Apostolic Age
- A.D. 312 Constantine made Christianity a state religion

### SMYRNA THE SUFFERING CHURCH (100-312 A.D.)

JESUS' TITLE: "The First and the Last, who was dead and came to life"

**COMMENDATION:** Afflicted, poor, persecuted, yet faithful and "rich" in the Lord

**COMPLAINT: NO COMPLAINT!** 

**REWARD:** the crown of Life; unhurt by the second death.

#### PERGAMOS - THE STATE CHURCH (312-606 A.D.)

- A.D. 312 Constantine made Christianity the state religion permeated with pagan customs and practices.
- A.D. 606 Beginning of the Holy Roman Catholic Church

## PERGAMOS THE STATE CHURCH (312-606 A.D.)

JESUS' TITLE: "Him who has the sharp, two-edged sword"

<u>COMMENDATION:</u> They have not renounced their faith despite the martyrdom of Antipas.

<u>COMPLAINT:</u> Marriage of the Church and the World, (Doctrine of Balaam; Doctrine of Nicolaitans)

**REWARD:** Hidden Manna; White stone with a new name
