



DOUBLETREE CHOCOLATE CHIP COOKIES

from the kitchen of Joann Hook

2 sticks butter, softened

3/4 cup + Tbsp sugar

3/4 cup light brown sugar

2 large eggs

1/4 tsp vanilla

1/4 tsp lemon juice

2/4 cups flour

1/2 cup rolled oats (old-fashioned)

1 tsp baking soda

1 tsp salt

Pinch of cinnamon

2/4 cups semi-sweet chocolate

chips

1/4 cups English walnuts, chopped

- 1. Preheat oven to 300°; line cookie sheet with parchment paper.
- 2. Cream butter, sugar, & brown sugar at medium speed for 2 minutes.
- 3. Add eggs, vanilla, & lemon juice at low speed for 30 seconds & then medium speed for 2 minutes.
- 4. At low speed, add flour, oats, baking soda, & cinnamon for 45 seconds; do not overmix. (I usually do this by hand.)
- 5. Stir in chocolate chips & nuts; blend thoroughly.
- 6. Scoop & roll 1-2 Tbsp of dough into a ball; place on baking sheet.
 7. Bake 20-23 min until the edges are golden brown; center will be soft.

Cool on baking sheet 30 min; remove to wire rack, cool completely.
