

### DISNEY GRILLED CHEESE SANDWICHES

### Cream Cheese Spread:

½ cup cream cheese ½ cup shredded cheddar 2 Tbsp heavy cream ¼ tsp coarse salt

### Garlic Spread:

1 cup mayo 1½ tsp minced garlic ½ tsp coarse salt

### Grilled 3-Cheese Sandwich:

- 8 slices Artisan bread 8 slices cheddar cheese
- 8 slices provolone cheese
- 1.Lay bread on cutting board; place 2 slices of cheddar cheese on four slices of bread & 2 slices of provolone cheese on the remaining 4 slices of bread.
- 2.Equally spoon cream cheese spread on the slices with provolone cheese; smooth over bread.
- 3. Press cheddar cheese covered bread & provolone bread together.
- 4. Heat a large skillet over medium heat for five minutes.
- 5.Brush both sides of sandwich with garlic spread; grill two minutes on each side until golden brown.
