#### **REV. DR. ROBERT EUGENE YOUNG**

Powerful, prophetic, and practical are words that best describe the ministry of Dr. Robert E. Young. He is an anointed preacher, author, musician, songwriter and worship leader. With the power and presence of God, his ministry has crossed generational and denominational boundaries.

Dr. Young was born in Baltimore, MD. He served as the Minister of Music, Youth Pastor and Assistant to the Pastor at the Silas First Missionary Baptist Church of Severna Park, MD.

Dr. Young graduated from Morgan State University in May 2003 with a Bachelor of Arts in Music with a concentration in Piano Performance. In May 2008, Dr. Young received a Masters in Divinity from the Samuel Dewitt Proctor School of Theology at Virginia Union. In May 2008, he was installed as the Pastor of the New Hope Baptist Church of Braddock, PA near the city of Pittsburgh.

In May 2014, Dr. Young received his Doctor of Ministry from the United Theological Seminary. His cohort focus was Preaching Prophetically in a Postmodern Culture, Communicating with Contemporary Audiences under the mentorship of Dr. William H. Curtis and Dr. Gina M. Stewart. His dissertation is entitled *Soulful Sermonizing; Black Preaching With A Blues Motif.* He was a speaker for Hampton New Voices at the Centennial Celebration of the Hampton University's Ministers Conference and Organist Guild.

In July of 2015, Dr. Young was installed as the fifteenth pastor of Mount Olivet Baptist Church in historic Peekskill, New York.

He served as a M.Div and D.Min mentor at New York Theological Seminary, Vice President of The Congress of Christian Education for the Empire Baptist State Convention and is a certified instructor for the National Baptist Sunday School Publishing Board and Congress of Christian Education.

He is the Pastor-Elect of Wayland Baptist Church of Baltimore, Md. A historic congregation with a legacy of missions, community development providing social services to the Garrison-Forest Park Community. Wayland oversees a multi-unit Senior citizen housing complex named Wayland Village.

Dr. Young is also a recent commissioned Captain in the United States Air Force serving as a reserve Chaplain at the Westover Air Reserve Base.

Dr. Young is the founder of The Healthy Preacher Movement; A network that promotes wholeness amongst clergy.

He has been honored with the privilege of being requested as a guest revivalist, speaker, lecturer, and musician for a host of Christian and secular events. He is the proud husband to the former Misha Renee Turner. They have two beautiful children, Robyn and Preston.

The work of the kingdom continues to advance with new challenges and demands, but Dr. Young is encouraged by the Word declared in Philippians 4:13, "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."

#### **History of Wayland Baptist Church**

In 1908, after the death of their Pastor at the Israel Baptist, a group of members left the church and began holding prayer meetings at each other's homes. Led by Deacon Robert Thrower, the prayer band grew and plans were made to organize a church. It would be named Wayland after Mrs. Thrower's home church in Virginia.

In 1917 with the promise of God and the leadership of Rev. Winston, the congregation purchased the Fourth Street Baptist Church. The Rev. J. H. Taylor, pastor of the Mt. Sinai Baptist Church was their spiritual advisor. Rev. Taylor recommended the Rev. J. Willis Winston to come and preach for them and in the fall of 1909 the congregation was formally organized and Rev. Winston began a 32 year pastorate at Wayland.

In 1912 the growing congregation moved from 1829 Orleans Street to the 1st church edifice at 1200 E. Lexington Street. The Lord continued to bless and the mortgage was paid in six years. The Missionary Society, Youth Choir, Sunday School and BYPU were formed along with the Usher Board. The Baptist Junior Missionary Convention was organized in Wayland Baptist Church at the corner of Broadway and Jefferson Street. The cost was \$20,000. The Lord continued to bless and Wayland continued to win souls for Christ.

In 1923, Rev. Winston was elected and accepted the presidency of Northern University in Long Branch, New Jersey. Reluctant to leave his sheep he did feel confident that the church would continue to progress. Sister Winston served as liaison and Rev. Winston was only a phone call away for important functions at the church. Without a constant spiritual leader, the congregation began to dwindle. In the late 1930's Rev. Elisha H. Reynolds, his wife Signora and members of the family cast their lot with Wayland. His arrival lent stability to the pulpit. His title was that of "Supply Pastor."

In 1941, Rev. Winston accepted the call to pastor the New Metropolitan Baptist Church. In 1943, Rev. Reynolds became the official 2nd pastor of the Wayland Baptist Church. Under his leadership, the church grew and the mortgage was burned for Broadway and Jefferson. Rev. Reynolds continued his pastorate until his death in June 1946. The church appointed the Rev. W.W. Payne and Rev. Ellwood Foster to officiate and minister to the Wayland congregation. They alternated between conducting service and rendering music. Rev. Payne was called to the pastorate in November 1946 but asked for 30 days to pray about the decision. On January 5, 1947, Rev. William W. Payne became Wayland's third pastor. The Lord continued to shower Wayland with blessings.

In 1952, we vacated Broadway and Jefferson and on July 6th of that year we marched to the beautiful edifice located on the corner of Monroe and Franklin Streets. It was purchased for \$65,000, which was a lot of money back then. Understand that half of the congregation could travel to Wayland on the #15 streetcar at the same time. But the Lord continued to bless and in one year alone, more than 600 people cast their lot

with Wayland. You could come to Wayland for any service and know that the Spirit of the Lord was present. The membership grew to over 2,000 and organizations were added, a new Allen organ was purchased, the interior was renovated, a baptismal pool installed, a second service was added and the Lord just showered Wayland with blessings.

In 1959, the mortgage was burned. The need for larger quarters was evident and after months of church meetings and negotiations, the congregation voted to purchase the Beth Tfiloh Hebrew Site on the corner of Garrison Blvd. and Fairview Avenue for \$450,000. On March 6, 1966, escorted by police, over 3,000 worshipers motored to our present church. In 1970, the beloved Rev. Payne tendered his resignation to heed the call of the Lord to personally minister to the least and the lost. Rev. Henson served as the Interim Pastor, Later that year, the Rev. Darneal F. Johnson, Ir. was offered the Pastorate of Wayland. As he was installed on April 4th that next year, he was faced with a membership of about 500, who had come through a traumatic "church split," a major debt of \$168,000 and other challenges. But you can look around and see, it is no secret what God did. Under his leadership, souls were still saved, we installed an elevator, glass doors and purchased our 1st minivan.

In 1977, we burned the mortgage. Rev. Johnson not only picked us up, but he led us to new heights. In 1989 after 18 years of service, Rev. Johnson submitted his resignation. After a nationwide search, the Wayland Baptist Church voted and accepted the 5th Pastor of the Wayland Baptist Church in the person of Rev. Dr. Hoffman Fisher Brown III. He came with a vision and a 20 year plan and in the last 15 years much has been accomplished. First of all, he continues to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ, property has been acquired, parking lot, affiliations with national and local organizations. We are constantly reminded "give God what's right, not what's left," and that prayer is the key to the kingdom, faith unlocks the door and study God's word.









# Biographical Sketch REV. DR. JESSE E. YOUNG

Pastor Jesse Eugene Young has been the pastor of the Silas First Baptist Church of Severna Park since 1989. This year he celebrates 32 years as the fourth pastor of Silas, 48 years of preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and 50 years in the musical field. His goal for Silas is to trust God for His guidance and to faithfully pastor the people as they become the church God would have them to be.


Pastor Young has been working hard from the day he stepped in the door to spiritually develop the members of Silas through praying, discipleship and evangelism. In the 32 years he has been at Silas, Pastor Young, with the help of the Lord, has created much enthusiasm among the members of the Silas congregation and the Anne Arundel County church community.

In order to better equip himself for greater ministry at Silas, Pastor Young earned his Bachelor in Religion from Liberty University in Lynchburg, VA and a Masters in Pastoral Counseling, magna cum laude, from the Andersonville Theological Seminary in Camilla, GA. He is presently working on his doctorate in theology at Andersonville.

Pastor Young also teaches three Bible studies each week, in addition to producing eight one-hour television broadcasts of the church at worship. These broadcasts are aired each Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday Saturday and Sunday in the Anne Arundel County, Baltimore City, Baltimore County and Howard County cable television viewing areas.

Along with his ministry work and other accomplishments, Pastor Young was blessed with the help of the Lord and the Silas congregation to erect a new sanctuary, fellowship hall with classrooms, and they were able to pay off the thirty-year mortgage in just six years. Under his pastoral leadership the church has just purchased the land that the original founder of Silas's house is presently situated on. These three quarters of an acre parcel of land will be used for the purpose of erecting the church's future Outreach and Community Center... Outside of Silas He also is a member of the Baptist Minister's Conference of Baltimore City and Vicinity and the founder of the Cluster Churches United for Christ in Anne Arundel County.

Pastor Young is married to Dr. Gwendolyn O. Young and they parent two children, Dr. Robert Eugene Young and Jessica Shari McLeod and are blessed with two granddaughters, Noelle and Robyn and two grandson Antonio Jesse and Preston His continuous theme for his walk in Christ is, "If Jesus Goes With Me, I'll Go Anywhere."


