



POLICY INFORMATION

We are licensed by the state and with that come some changes and guidelines that we will be following very strictly. Take a moment and look through this to make sure you understand and are prepared.

▪ Mask

- Children are NOT required to wear mask

State licensing does not require them for children at all.

We are aware that the CDC does recommend wearing mask for everyone over the age of 2.

If you would like to send a mask for your child to wear, we will do everything we can to help them keep it on but remember we can not guarantee it will stay on.

▪ Teacher/Staff & Mask

- Teachers will be wearing mask during the following times:

At drop off & pick up while talking to parents

Anytime a teacher/staff is talking with another adult teacher/staff that is not in their direct classroom.

Teachers will NOT be required to wear mask in the classroom.

Our little friends are going to be nervous and scared enough coming back to school after this long break. They will be taken out of the car by people wearing mask, we feel this is enough trauma for our little friends.

If a teacher/staff member wants to keep the mask on, they will be allowed to do that. We will work with those kids to make sure they feel safe and not scared.

▪ Parents/Designated Adults

At drop off & pick up parents will be required to wear a mask while we are getting our friends in or out of the car seat.

▪ Health & Temperatures

Temperatures will be taken 3 times a day for teachers/staff & children.

Drop Off, Mid-Day, After Nap

Remember, NOT everyone with a fever will be diagnosed with COVID, or even need testing.

If your child is sent home with a fever, they will be required to stay out of school a minimum of **24 hours** and until fever free for **24 hours** without the aid of medication.

- Health: Keep your child home if any of the below apply over the last 72 hours.

Temp of 100 or higher

2 or more Diarrhea

If your child has thrown up for ANY reason

Runny nose or cold like symptoms (even if you think it is allergies)

Pink Eye or Goopy Eye

Rash of Any Kind

■ Classrooms

Classrooms have been disinfected and deep cleaned.

Toys that are not easily washed everyday have been removed from classrooms.

Classrooms will be cleaned & disinfected during playground time while children are out of the room for a mid-day clean.

Tables & Chairs will be cleaned and disinfected after lunch and while our friends are napping.

All Nap Mats will be disinfected at the end of the day.

All Classrooms will be cleaned & disinfected one more time before the staff leaves at 3pm each day.

We also have a cleaning crew that will come in after 5:00pm to clean the building also.

■ Teachers

Teacher to Child Ratios have been lowered in most classes.

Group class sizes have been lowered in most classes.

Your child's teacher will be their teacher everyday unless they are out for something.
