Questions To Discuss:

What does it mean to value others more than yourself?

Can you think of a time you looked out for the good of others?

Application Activity: SERVE IT UP!

What to do: Gather your items and explain to your child what you have planned for them to do to serve at home.

What to say:

This was a big job and I have got to say, it might not be my favorite way to spend the morning or afternoon. How did you feel while we were working? How do you feel right now?

*Make this personal and share the most meaningful service project you have ever participated in; or share a time when you were served with humility and felt loved by God in a sincere and tangible way.

Prayer Activity:

What to say:

Jesus put others first in everything He did. He even put YOU first. In fact, Jesus came so that you can have a relationship with Him and live with God forever!

When you believe in your heart that Jesus is who He said He was, and when you ask Him to forgive your sins, He will!

*Open the Bible to John 3:16
