

The boulevard on the south, west and north side of Grace contained 18 trees. All of them were Ash trees susceptible to Emerald Ash Boer. The City was willing to remove some trees in order to reduce the risk of all of the trees dying at one time. Nine of the trees were removed late last summer. The City will replace the trees with 9 new trees. Trees scheduled to be planted are two Japanese Tree Lilac; two Spring Snow Crab; two Redmond Linden and three Sienna Glen Maples. The cost of the trees has not yet been determined, but is expected to be approximately \$70-80 per tree. A tree fund has been established if anyone wishes to donate to this project.


Aluminum Cans for Missions



IRA Charitable Rollover

A Tax-Saving Way to help Grace Lutheran Church

If you are 70 ½ years or older, you may be interested in taking advantage of a simple way to benefit Grace Lutheran Church. The IRA (individual retirement account) Charitable Rollover may lower your income and taxes from your IRA withdrawals.

The Criteria of an IRA Charitable Rollover:

- You must be 70 ½ or older when the transfer is made.
- The transfer must go directly from your IRA administrator to the church.
- The gift counts toward your IRA RMD (required minimum distribution).
- IRA rollover gifts are limited to \$100,000 per taxpayer per year.
- The distribution is not reported as income, so there is no adverse effect on income tax.
- IRA charitable rollovers can be used to fulfill a pledge you may have made to Grace Lutheran Church.

Benefits of an IRA charitable rollover:

- Reduce your taxable income, even if you do not itemize your deductions.
- You can avoid taxes on transfers of up to \$100,000 from your IRA to Grace Lutheran Church.
- You can satisfy your RMD (required minimum distribution).
- Gifts can be larger than your RMD and still receive the tax saving benefits.
