Ash Wednesday begins the season of Lent

"Open My Life, Lord" is the theme of the Lenten services for 2022 beginning with Ash Wednesday on March 2nd. In the Sermon on the Mount from the Gospel of St. Matthew, Jesus commends almsgiving prayer and fasting but emphasizes that spiritual devotion must not be done for show, a reminder for our journey towards Easter of what giving from the heart means as we humble ourselves before God.

During the weeks of Lent, as we open our lives to Christ teachings, we will open our eyes to view the world through the eyes of Christ; open our hands in ways to serve God by serving others; open our ears to really listen to Jesus teaching and not just hear words; open our hearts to trust as we respond in openness to God's calling; and open our lives to Christ who lives in us.

God reminds us in Isaiah on Ash Wednesday, that outward observance is no substitute for genuine fasting that results in acts of justice, such as feeding the hungry, sheltering the homeless, and clothing the naked. Sincere repentance will lead to a dramatic improvement of their condition.

Ash Wednesday service will be held at Grace Lutheran at Noon and once again at 7 pm on March 2nd with Holy Communion and Imposition of Ashes offered at both services. Lenten services continue at 7 pm each Wednesday evening until Holy Week, March 9 through April 6.

All are welcome.

Jamboree to feature Brian B and the Company Cowgirls

Brian B and the Company Cowgirls will be featured at the March 20th Country Gospel Jamboree at Grace Lutheran Church in Watertown, SD. The Sunday afternoon 2 to 4 pm jamboree venue invites local and area musicians, whether vocalist or instrumentalist, to share their musical talents with the featured group on a country gospel song or two.

Brian Bergeleen of Wessington Springs, leader of the group started his musical endeavors in the mid 1960's. He has had a guitar in his hands since a very young age and with his cousin and a friend, started playing country music in dance halls and at county fairs.

Brian's cousin Kyle Evans, began singing with the small band which became known as Kyle Evans and the Company Cowboys, playing at over 1000 Professional Rodeos around the country through the years, including singing the National Anthem at the National Finals Rodeo in Las Vegas. After Kyle's passing in an accident in 2001, the 3 Company Cowboys continued to play for dances & rodeos.

In 2002, Brian went to Nashville to cut a gospel CD including four of his own songs and a 10-song country CD of all his originals. He was inducted into the Legends of SD Country Music Association and the Dakota Musicians Association Hall of Fame in 2006.

Brian also performs at various events with his daughters and grandchildren, who seem to be following in his footsteps. His family inspired many of the songs he has written and will share along with other favorites.

The Company Cowgirls includes his sisters and daughters singing favorites mixed with a little storytelling.

Of note, Brian B is "100% Norwegian, so please don't hold that against him" and come enjoy his music along with the Company

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

I am so proud to be your pastor. Grace is a place active in love, and it shows. I see it as couples are smiling and enjoying time together at dance class. People working in the kitchen to serve the banquet. Wednesday school children jumping up with their noisy offerings. And the many volunteers who work to hold comedy programs, jamborees, craft and vendor shows, Mother and daughter banquets, donate items for silent auctions and create beautiful quilts for others, to name just some of the actions that show love is active at Grace.

We read in Psalms 85: "⁴Restore us again, O God of our salvation, and put away your indignation toward us. ⁵Will you be angry with us forever? Will you prolong your anger to all generations? ⁶Will you not revive us again, so that your people may rejoice in you? ⁷Show us your steadfast love, O LORD, and grant us your salvation."

There may have been some hiccups in the long history for Grace Lutheran, but God is faithful. He will restore His people and remove the difficulties you have experienced. He will cause a revival and turn your sadness into rejoicing, as has already begun.

In faith at the annual meeting, you took a leap to include in the budget the position of a Deacon or Associate Minister. At the last council meeting, members volunteered to form a call committee and were asked to hit the ground running. This past week those forming the committee met by ZOOM with SD Synod staff to look at options and discuss our needs at Grace Lutheran.

Intern Brenda has worked on Outreach into the community organizing a Las Posadas in December. On Ash Wednesday we will once again invite our Spanish speaking friends to join us in a Spanish speaking service, something we hope to do for Easter as well. This is just the beginning of work to reach out and welcome our neighbor as Grace has done in the past sponsoring refugees in the community.

Next year, on September 16th and 17th of 2023, Grace will celebrate their 140th Anniversary. It will be a time to look back at all that you have faithfully heard God call you to do and rejoice in the faithfulness of those who have come before you. It will be a time to look ahead at the many opportunities God has given you to serve Him as you continue to show faith active in love. It will be a time of celebration for the many blessings God has granted you. It will also be a time to be humble and know that God has chosen you to fulfill His mission and ministry through Grace in numerous ways for years to come that you have yet to discover. God showing His love through you.

Second Chronicles tells us: "14 if my people who are called by my name humble themselves, pray, seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land. 15 Now my eyes will be open and my ears attentive to the prayer that is made in this place. 16 For now I have chosen and consecrated this house so that my name may be there forever; my eyes and my heart will be there for all time."

There is much to do, and with prayer, I see a rebirth happening at Grace. You will never be the church that once was. You will be a different church for this different world we live in, transformed, and healed.

Jesus' teaching calls for imagination and renewed actions of love that reach out in unique ways to all people. Paul writes in Romans 12, "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you may discern what is the will of God-- what is good and acceptable and perfect."

How will you be the church of the future? How will Grace be open and welcoming to the call of Christ Jesus to serve the neighbor, care for the oppressed, and be the face of God to others?

You may not know the answer to that question today. But through faith, with God's help and grace to discern His will, go forward hearing His voice and serving others, as He calls you to do. "Restore us, O LORD God of hosts; let your face shine, that we may be saved." (Psalm 80:19)

Absent were Denise Biller, Ted Frost, Gena Urevig and Rhonda Lorenz..

A motion to approve the agenda was made by Geri Mohror and seconded by Adam Wientjes. Motion carried. A motion to approve the minutes for the January 13, 2022 meeting was made by Adam Wientjes and seconded by Paul Henrichs. Motion carried.

Items:

- **1. Financial Report--** Cindy Vander Leest reported the monthly income to the general fund was \$22,352, the weekly average giving was \$4,470 and the weekly worship attendance was 113. A motion to accept the financial report and pay the bills was made by Mark Briley and seconded by Geri Mohror. Motion carried.
- **2. Pastor's Report---** Pastor Cheryl continues to visit and serve communion at our care centers and had 1 funeral. The Prairie Coteau Conference Pastors meeting will be at Grace, 9:30 thru lunch on February 15, 2022. An elementary fun night for 3-6th graders will be held on February 18th. Monthly report was given to all council members with upcoming events.

Old Business:

- **1. Fundraiser Committee**—Committee met on February 6th. The comedy night was held on January 28th with good attendance and around \$1200 was cleared for the roof fund. Dance classess will end on Feb. 15th with a meal provided by member dancers. Update on the Kubota tickets. Some were sold at the farm show and we will also sell them at the Big Boy toy show Feb. 26-27th. The drawing will be held on February 28th at 6 pm. The Country Jamboree will be on March 20th from 2-4 pm and cost \$10.00. A freewill lunch prior to the jamboree and also a silent auction from noon to 3:30 pm. A Craft/Vendor fair is planned for April 2nd. There will be another Bake Sale on Palm Sunday, April 10th. The Mollie B Concert will be held May 13th. They are looking for sponsorships.
- 2.Constitution and By-Law update- We are waiting for a response from the Synod.
- **3. Banquet-** Discussion on Monday Night Banquet was held as they had requested some board members and treasurer position from Grace Lutheran. This was tabled until next meeting.

A motion to adjourn was made by Rich Dunn, seconded by Geri Mohror, motion passed.



Our website enables you to give financial gifts online, anytime, anywhere from the Giving link at glcwtn.org. On the Giving page, you can chose an account, enter the amount and give to the option you want. You can also provide gift details. It will display the account and amount you have chosen, AND the processing fee which you can add to the gift so it is not charged to the church. In the memo add a note if this is in memory, in celebration, or an appreciation gift. You will be asked to confirm all the information before processing.

IRA Charitable Rollover

A Tax-Saving Way to help Grace Lutheran Church

If you are 70 ½ years or older, you may be interested in taking advantage of a simple way to benefit Grace Lutheran Church. The IRA (individual retirement account) Charitable Rollover may lower your income and taxes from your IRA withdrawals.

The Criteria of an IRA Charitable Rollover:

You must be 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ or older when the transfer is made.

The transfer must go directly from your IRA administrator to the church.

The gift counts toward your IRA RMD (required minimum distribution).

IRA rollover gifts are limited to \$100,000 per taxpayer per year.

The distribution is not reported as income, so there is no adverse effect on income tax.

IRA charitable rollovers can be used to fulfill a pledge you may have made to Grace Lutheran Church.

Benefits of an IRA charitable rollover:

Reduce your taxable income, even if you do not itemize your deductions.

You can avoid taxes on transfers of up to \$100,000 from your IRA to Grace Lutheran Church.

You can satisfy your RMD (required minimum distribution).

Gifts can be larger than your RMD and still receive the tax saving benefits.


