Creation:

Christmas:

The prophets foretold of a day when God would bring a rescue, a savior, to bring us out of our desperate situation. Well, just as prophesied, Jesus Christ, the Son of God, came into the world to rescue people from darkness. On the night of Jesus' birth the angel proclaimed: "Fear not, for behold, I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. Life of Jesus:

Tomb:

Jesus died for our sins, according to the Scriptures. His death paid the penalty for our sins. But this is not the end of the story, three days later, Easter Sunday, He rose from the grave proving that He also defeated death.

The bible says, "O death, where is your victory? O death, where is your sting?" The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law; but thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Why Easter?

- Easter (and all year long) is when we worship the creator of all things!
- Easter is when we admit that we have broken lives because of sin!
- Easter is when we understand that God made a way to deal with our sin problem!
- Easter is when we celebrate Jesus, who lived a perfect life, died our death, to pay our sin debt, and gives all those who would repent and believe in Him, forgiveness, freedom and eternal life!

(John 3:16-18) For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.

Easter is freedom for those who would receive Jesus. This is good news, but It is only good news if you receive Jesus!
