

In Colossians 3:16-17, Paul tells us to "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God. And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him." This comes directly on the heels of him telling us to "put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony" (Colossians 3:14). I read that and I wonder "what's with all the musical references?". There is nothing like a beautiful "harmony" (definition: the combination of simultaneously sounded musical notes to produce chords and chord progressions having a pleasing effect). Musical chords or harmonies are not comprised of replications of the same note. The notes are different, yet they complement one another to make beautiful music. In his letter to the church in Colossae, Paul describes how our lives are to be lived out in community (the church) because healthy relationships are music to God's ears.
