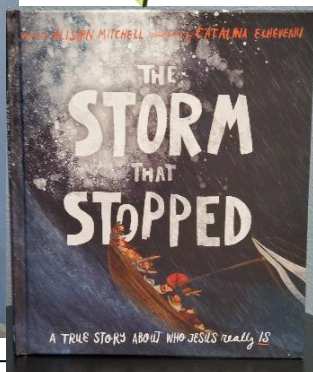

SRC FAMILY RECIPE SHARE

Cinnamon Apples

What You Need: 10 Fuji or Gala apples, ½ of a cup of water, 4 tablespoons of sugar, 1 teaspoon of cinnamon, ½ a teaspoon of nutmeg, a handful of flour, knife, and a pot.

Let's Get Cooking!

1. Peel and core the apples
2. Slice the apples
3. Put the apples into the pot and put all the ingredients in (water, sugar, cinnamon, and nutmeg)
4. Stir until ingredients are mixed well and covering all the apples. Periodically stir while the apples are cooking.
5. Bring the apples to a boil
6. Once the apples begin to boil, bring the apples down to a simmer until they are turning clear around the edges, or until they are soft
7. Enjoy!!

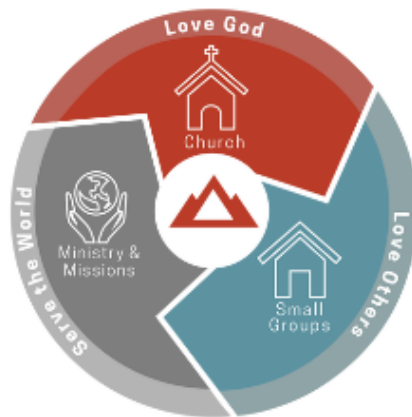

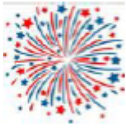
