### APPLE SAUCE JELLO

#### What You Need:

- 3 cups unsweetened applesauce
- 2 3-oz packages of any flavor gelatin
- 1 ½ cups Sprite or 7-Up

- Remove from heat, stir in gelatin until dissolved.

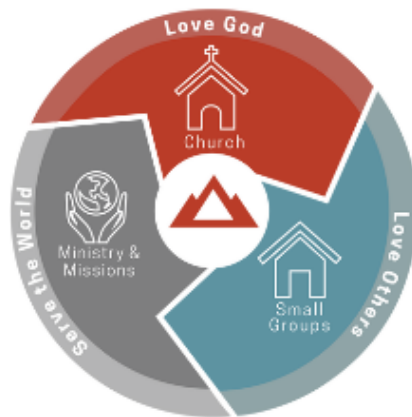

In 700 BC, 2 new months, January and February, were added. This moved the 6<sup>th</sup> month to the 8<sup>th</sup> month.
