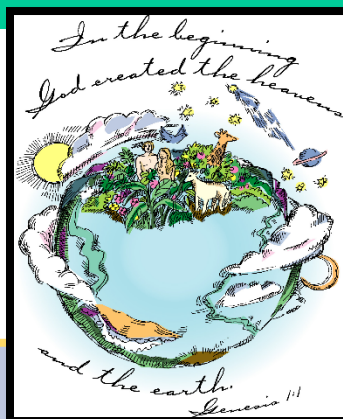

PASTOR'S NOTE

Dear Parents:

Here at Summit Ridge Church, we use The Gospel Project for Kids by Lifeway. The curriculum goes through the entire bible in three years. We just completed our last lesson in Revelation last month and start back from the beginning in Genesis the first Sunday of September. How exciting!

This is a wonderful time for families to come together around God's word and to talk about all that God has done. Through simple question and answers you can reinforce what God's word says and increase your children's theological literacy. Here are some examples:

- Q.** Who made you?
A. God made me (Gen. 1:26-27, 2:7; Eccles. 12:1; Acts 17:24-29)
- Q.** What else did God make?
A. God made all things. (Gen 1, Acts 14:15; Rom. 11:36; Col.1:16)
- Q.** Why did God make you and all things?
A. For His own glory. (Ps. 19:1; Jer. 9:23-24; Rev. 4:11)
- Q.** How can you glorify God?
A. By loving Him and doing what He commands. (Eccles. 12:13; Mark 12:29-31; John 15:8-10; 1 Cor 10:31)
- Q.** Why should you glorify God?
A. Because He made me and takes care of me. (Rom. 11:36; Rev. 4:11)
- Q.** Are there more gods than one?
A. There is only one God. (Deut. 6:4; Jer. 10:10; Mark 12:29; Acts 17:22-31)

Simple questions that reinforce God's truth.

Title: My ABC Bible Verses from the Psalms

Author: Susan Hunt and Richie Hunt

Illustrated By: Connie Gabbert

Synopsis: The Psalms teach us to praise God as they talk about how great God really is! This colorfully illustrated children's book presents a verse from Psalms alongside each letter of the alphabet with an engaging story—helping kids to memorize verses from the Psalms, learn their ABCs, grow in their relationship with God, and understand why God is worthy of our worship.

SRC FAMILY RECIPE SHARE

PIZZA FROM SCRATCH by Tiffany Cooper

Makes two medium pizzas dough using a standing mixer

Ingredients: 3 cups flour, 2 tsp (1 packet) instant yeast, ½ tbsp (1 glug) olive oil, ¾ tsp (2 large pinches) kosher salt, 1-½ cups warm water

1. Proof yeast in your warm water. Add a pinch of sugar to help "wake up" yeast. Allow to sit until starts to bubble.
2. Combine all ingredients in mixing bowl, reserve 1 tbsp water.
3. Mix until a loose dough forms. If a ball doesn't form, add rest of the water. If dough is too wet and sticky, add a pinch of flour.
4. Using dough hook attachment, start on low speed. Gradually increase medium until a ball forms. This should take about 30 seconds. If dough does not release from the sides of the bowl, add a pinch of flour. If dough is very dry and floury, add a small amount of water.
5. Once dough forms into a ball, allow mixer to knead for 8 minutes at medium-high.
6. Form dough into a ball with floured hands and transfer to an oiled bowl, cover, and allow to rise in a warm place.
7. Once dough has doubled in size (about an hour - hour and half), divide in half and form into equal sized balls of dough (or 4 smaller balls for individual sized pizzas!).
8. Allow to rest on a floured surface and cover with a damp towel (about 30 minutes).
9. Preheat oven to 450*
10. Roll out each ball on a sheet of parchment paper, transfer to pizza pans, and top with your favorite toppings!
11. Bake at 450* for 10-12 minutes, or until the cheese is bubbly.

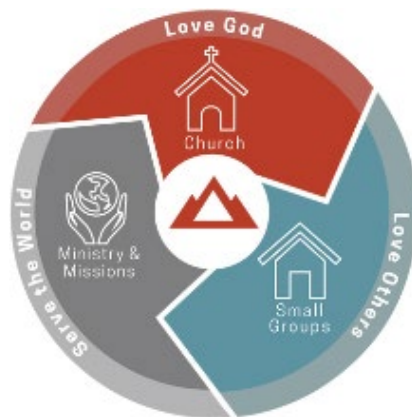
