Planning Your Wedding

First Steps

Step 1 – Fill out the required Wedding Information Questionnaire and the Room Reservation Request at GraceHudson.org. You may either submit these online or mail them to the church office, Attn: Weddings.

Step 2 – Once all the required information is received, you will call the church office (978-562-8550) and set up an appointment with a pastor to discuss your wedding plans including: choice of officiating pastor, choice of Wedding Coordinator, registration for the pre-marital course, taking the Prepare and Enrich Inventory, facility needs and sanctuary set up, wedding fees, and guidelines, etc.

Step 3 – You will attend your upcoming required pre-marital course. Sessions are from 6-8 weeks.

Step 4 – You will complete the required Prepare and Enrich Inventory. This inventory is an in-depth questionnaire that includes a personal workbook helping to identify the strengths you bring into the relationship along with growth areas you can work on.

Fees & Guidelines

Payment of Fees: All payments are due and must be paid in full at least one week prior to your wedding date.

Pastor Honorarium: \$200 suggested and payable to the officiating pastor.

Wedding Coordinator: \$200 required and payable to the coordinator.

Sanctuary Use: \$200 required and payable to the church.

Custodial: Weddings after 2:00 PM on Saturday will be assessed a \$100 surcharge required and payable to the church.

Sound Tech: \$100 required and payable to the individual.

Music: \$100 - \$300 each and payable to the individual or individuals. It is the responsibility of the Bride/Groom to make arrangements for all music. Music should be cleared by the officiating pastor. Referrals of individual soloists, musicians, etc. can be made upon request.

Prepare & Enrich: \$35.00 required.

Check List of Things to Do

- Complete the steps listed in this policy brochure which include scheduling your pre-marital course, pastoral pre-marital counseling, and completing the Prepare and Enrich Inventory.
- Remember to obtain your marriage license and bring it with you to the rehearsal or give it to the officiating pastor before that time.
- Purchase your unity candle, aisle runner, or other supplies. Note No other candles are permitted.
- Print your programs/order of service bulletins.
- Pay additional fees in full for contracted services.
- Meet with a trained evaluator to process your Prepare and Enrich Evaluation.
- Finalize the rehearsal and ceremony details with the officiating pastor.
- Make arrangements for flower delivery and photographer to connect with the Wedding Coordination on the wedding day.
