We are delighted to have you and your child(ren) attend Stay 'n Play. This is an exciting opportunity for parents and caregivers to socialize with their child or children in a safe and fun environment.

If you would like to receive e-mails about Stay 'N Play, please fill out our registration form. Once you have completed this form, you will only need to sign in each week.

We would like to draw your attention to a couple of issues which are important to the overall running of Stay 'n Play, ensuring its success:

- We will follow the Hudson Public School calendar. If there is a school vacation on a Wednesday, there will be no Stay 'n Play. If Hudson public schools are delayed, released early, or cancelled due to inclement weather, Stay 'N Play will be cancelled. Exception is that we are open when Hudson Public Schools have a 1/2 day.
- While you are attending Stay 'n Play, you are responsible for your child(ren)'s well being. We will provide the play experiences while you supervise your child's play.
- We will make a snack available for the children. If you choose to bring your own snack for your child, please do not bring any peanut products. In addition, please have snack in the snack room. This will help keep our environment safe for children with allergies.
- There is a diaper changing facility available in the men's and women's restroom and also in the restroom between Rooms 111 and 110.
- For the protection of all children, please do not attend Stay 'N Play if your child has a persistent cough or fresh cold (less than 4 days) or if your child has had a fever, diarrhea, or a rash during the past 24 hours. Adhering to this policy will help everyone stay healthier at Stay 'N Play.
- In order to keep the younger children safe, we would like all bike activity to remain in Room 115 except during circle time.

Schedule for Stay 'n Play:

9:30: Stay 'N Play begins. A craft will be available.
10:15-10:30: Circle time for children 2 and under
10:45-11:00: Circle time for children 3 and older
11:15: Clean- up time begins
11:30: Stay 'N Play ends
