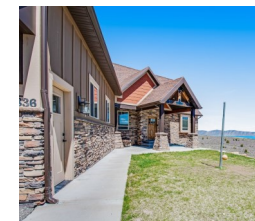

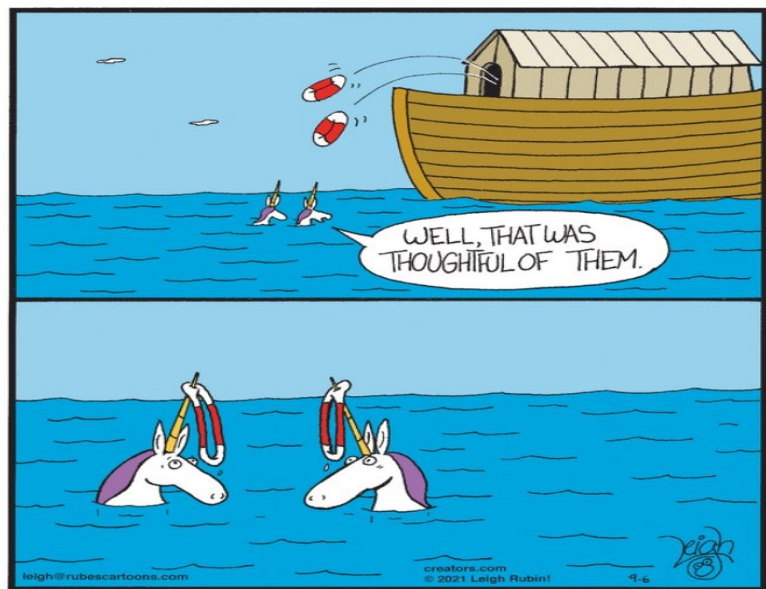
Obviously, we need more donations to ensure each box has what it needs. (T-shirts to fit age 2-12)
