 - Full deity and humanity of Jesus Christ
 - Spiritual lostness of the entire human race
 - Substitutionary atonement and bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ
 - Salvation by grace through faith alone in Christ
 - The physical return of Christ
 - The authority and inerrancy of Scripture
- 4. Become a faithful member of a Gospel Community Group
- 5. Give of your financial resources to support this ministry as an act of worship
- 6. Give of your time by looking for opportunities to serve this church
- 7. Follow the leadership of the elders in the areas of ministry direction, church discipline, and overall church governance.
- 8. Give of your prayers as you faithfully intercede for this church
- 9. Because unity is so important to our ability to glorify God and shine as lights in the world, make every attempt to reconcile and heal broken relationships within this church body.
- 10. Understand that continued membership carries with it active participation in the life of the church.
