Thank you for being so responsive during the start of our in-person learning including keeping your children home when they are showing any symptoms of illness. Some of you have even been tested as a precautionary step. We are grateful that you are partnering with us in keeping our campus safe.

We wanted to make you aware of a [bulletin published by the Tacoma Pierce County Health Department \(TPCHD\) on September 30](#).

We are monitoring the situation in Pierce County as well as keeping a close eye on our own campus community. We are encouraged that the protocols that we have in place are keeping our TBS community healthy and allowing us to stay open and in-person. We are very excited to welcome back our high school students on Monday, October 5.

As we move further into the fall and winter months, we are fortunate to have different learning tracks based on information given to us by the TPCHD.

1. If the TPCHD provides *recommendations*, we will be continuing with our in-person and on campus learning plan. We request our families continue:
 - a. keeping your student home when they show any symptoms of illness
 - b. wearing face coverings on campus
 - c. encouraging good hygiene
 - d. limiting your family's exposure to others when not on campus

2. If the TPCHD gives *requirements*, we are prepared to return to our remote learning plan.

We anticipate future information to schools will be given as recommendations, but we wanted to make all our families aware of the movement and communications that are being presented to us as a school.
