Our guiding principle is to partner with parents in promoting attire that is modest, safe, and comfortable as well as respects the individual tastes of students.

General Guidelines

- Student apparel should cover an area from the upper chest to the midthigh.
- On Fridays, students are encouraged to wear TBS attire.

If you have questions, please contact an administrator.

Tops should not:

Contain inappropriate images, words, ads

Have rips or tears below the shoulders

Have spaghetti straps (including camis)

Include strapless attire (halter tops, tube tops), low cut or immodest necklines

Be cut-off or muscle shirts

Bottoms should not:

Expose the leg above mid-thigh

Have rips, tears, or holes above mid-thigh

Include spandex shorts without running shorts

Include leggings or running tights without coverage to mid-thigh

Footwear

For safety reasons:

- Elementary students are required to wear shoes that have a back strap
- Secondary are encouraged to keep safety in mind

Accessories

Ear gauges or facial posts are not permitted while on campus or during off campus school functions & events

Vulgar, racist, sexual, or gang tattoos are not permitted

Hats, beanies, and hoods are to be removed during chapel, ceremonies, and based on classroom protocol and teacher preference
