All Highlighted items MUST be brought to class on the first day of school.

Item	Quantity	Description/ Specifics
Bible	1	Old and New Testament with a concordance, Study Bible preferred Students will be required to bring this with them to every class. NKJV, NIV, and ESV translations are acceptable.
Three-ring binder	1 (2 inch)	2 inch durable 3 ring binder to be used in every class **The typical student goes through 2-3 a year. Replace as needed.
Notebook dividers	Varies by grade	All Grades: at least six-preferably plastic 8th grade Algebra: 2 additional dividers
Calculator	Varies by grade	7th grade: scientific calculator (please label with student's name) 8th grade: Pre-Algebra students need a scientific calculator (please label with student's name). No Calculator required for Algebra.
Notebook paper	5 packs	College ruled (no colored paper) Bring one package at a time and keep the extras at home. Replace as needed.
Pencils with erasers	5 dozen	#2 pencils or mechanical pencils with #2 lead Bring 4-6 to school and keep the extras at home. Replace as needed.
Red pen	5	used for correcting assignments
Ball point pens	6	blue or black ink only Bring 2-4 to school and keep the extras at home.
Composition notebook	Varies by grade	Each notebook will be used solely for one class/subject 6th grade: 3 total - English, Math, Chapel 7th grade: 5 total - Math, Science, History, English, Chapel 8th grade: 5 total - Math (Pre-Algebra), Science, History, English, Chapel
Spiral notebook	Varies by grade	6th grade: 4 total - 2 Science, 2 History 7th grade: None 8th grade: 2 or 3 - approx. 70 pg. spiral notebooks (Algebra Only)
Pencil pouch	1	Pouch should have three holes for fitting in the binder.
Highlighters	1	assorted package (at least three different colors)
Library card	1	A current card from King or Pierce County or Tacoma Public Library. Bring card or number on the first day.
Kleenex	2 boxes	large/family size boxes
Paper towels	1 roll	large/family size roll
Dry Erase markers	4	blue, brown, red or black in color and a cloth for erasing
USB drive	1	any size or brand (minimum 8GB recommended)
3"x5" cards 100 per pack	4 packs	lined index cards Bring 1 pack the first day of school.
3-pronged report folder	3	used during the year and should be kept at home
Glue stick	1	Elmer's or UHU brand recommended
Protractor	1	(optional)
12 inch ruler	1	must have inches and millimeters
Colored pencils	1	12 count or more – bring to class when notified – keep extras in your locker until needed
Graph paper	1 pack	¼" squares
Scissors	1	6th grade: small pair that can be kept in the classroom
