Session Highlights

In June, the Session heard reports from Pastor Greg and Executive Director Mike Steel on increases in attendance in both worship services. We discussed the church's mission to be Christ centered, called into community and making ripples. We heard a report from Elder Sean McCabe about the recent Presbytery meeting. The scouting program (Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts) sponsored by Northminster is seeking a new Scout Master.

Committee Reports:

- Finance: Income remains above expenses. 25% of giving is unpledged, making budget planning more challenging.
 Discussed stewardship campaign for the fall.
- Facilities: Compton Road electronic sign being replaced. An additional defibrillator has been ordered; this will be stored in the usher's closet in the narthex. Monitors from Room 5 (now the nursery) have been moved to the Commons and Sanctuary hallway.
- Worship: Will resume passing a collection plate in Traditional Worship this fall.
- Discipleship: Numerous family activities planned for summer. Student Ministry and Young Adult small groups continuing through the summer. Embrace Grace birthing class attracted new attendees.
- **Staff Development:** Hired JT Harrison as Sunday Children's Ministry Assistant. Searching for a second vocalist for Modern Worship Band.
- **Vision:** Looking at small groups and emphasis on "Doing Life Together", welcoming new members to groups and building relationships. Also focusing on building a legacy of faith; faithful giving and sharing faith stories.


