

SERMON STUDY GUIDE

READ SCRIPTURE: Luke 24:13 – 35 ESV

RESPOND:

- **HEAD – Questions to help us better understand God.**
 - *What does it say? (Observation); What does it mean? (Interpretation)*
 - Verse 16 says that their eyes were kept from recognizing Jesus. Why weren't they able to recognize him? Read the following for examples: Lk. 9:45; Lk. 18:34; Jn. 20:14-15; Jn. 21:4.
 - On whom does Luke place the human responsibility of Jesus' crucifixion? (v. 20)
 - In verse 26, Jesus says that it was necessary for him to suffer and enter into his glory. What does he mean by this? Why was it necessary? How could these early disciples miss all the OT passages that spoke of Jesus' death?
 - Jesus not only walked with these two, he also stayed with them and shared a meal with them. (vv. 28-31) When did they recognize Jesus? (also v. 36) For further study, check out the similarities between this account and what happened in Lk. 22:9 and Lk. 9:16.
 - Why did their hearts burn within them, as Jesus talked with them on the road? (v. 32; cf. v. 27)

- **HEART – Questions to help us be like Jesus.**
 - *How does Jesus need to change your heart? (Reflection)*
 - In his sermon, Pastor Butch said, "There are no hopeless situations; only those who have grown hopeless about them." In what ways, does Jesus' resurrection fill you with hope? Be specific.
 - Are you still in awe of Jesus' broken body and shed blood? (vv. 30-31)
 - Does your heart burn within you, when the Holy Spirit reveals Scripture to you? (v. 32)

- **HANDS – Questions to help us join in Jesus' mission.**
 - *How will you live and tell? (Application)*
 - What in your life needs to change, so Jesus' sacrifice on the cross might inspire heartfelt worship in your everyday life? (vv. 30-31)
 - How will you commit to spending time with God each day, so He might transform your life? (v. 32)
 - Write down the *one thing* you want to remember from this text. Now, share your *one thing* with someone who needs to hear it!
