From the Pastor's Desk

Hello Shiloh Members,

Strategic Priority One: Multiply

Last month I shared our four strategic priorities for the next four years, Multiply, Mentorship, Media, and Multipurpose space. Our first priority is multiplying. Multiply is the process of sharing the everlasting gospel. We are called to work with Jesus and each other to fulfill Jesus' great commission, "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen." (Matthew 28:19-20 KJV) Also, Jesus said, "And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come." (Matthew 24:14 KJV) We must reach people to share the gospel with them to grow.

We are challenged to follow Jesus' example- "Christ's method alone will give true success in reaching the people. The Savior mingled with men as one who desired their good. He showed sympathy for them, ministered to their needs, and won their confidence. Then He bade them, 'Follow Me' (Ellen G. White, Ministry of Healing, p. 143). strategies are intentionally built into the life and activities of our church.

Each member and ministry are challenged to plan outreach activities to share the message of Jesus. Evangelism campaigns are scheduled yearly to follow up with ministry outreach activities. Some goals are:

- By the end of 2022, to increase the membership by 3%
- Hire a Bible worker by 2023
- By the end of 2023, increase our membership by 5%.
- By the end of 2024, increase the membership by 10%.
- Five ministries per year will host outreach events (focusing on health, family, children, etc.).
- By the end of 2024, develop a written plan to start a new mission church in north or west cobb county.
- Start an online membership group by 2024.


