Position description:

The Molalla Adult Community Center serves over 1,700 seniors who currently use the Center as well as 100 seniors who depend on the weekly Meals on Wheels program. It is Foothills' desire to help facilitate these services and activities to the seniors of the Molalla area. It requires a collective effort from the faith community, the local businesses, civic clubs and private individuals; and together, we can take care of those who once took care of us.

Our Meals on Wheels drivers are meeting the basics need of many of our local seniors by delivering pre-made meals and reassurance to the clients. It's important that volunteers are passionate about the elderly and that they have the gift of encouragement to offer a friendly connection with them upon each delivery. People skills are important because of the relational aspect of this role. The ability to be flexible with changes on routes is also important. Arriving on time and delivering meals in a timely matter is important. Hours for this position vary by route but begin at 11am and finish from 12pm to 2pm on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday.
