Pens, pencils & sharpeners, pencil cases, erasers, crayons, washable markers, calculators, child's scissors


Jacks, puzzles, play dough, small etch-a-sketches, stickers

Donation bins are located in various locations around the church



October usually brings the first frost in South Mississippi. With cooler temperatures come high school football and the county fair. This year's officials have canceled the fair, and football certainly is not as usual. However, the church is getting back to a new normal. We're back! A ninety-eight-percent or better chance of surviving Covid19 for most of us begs the question, "Why not go to church?" We stand a better chance of dying in a car accident than from the virus. Highland will continue to social-distance in the church, and there will be masks available for those who would like to wear one. We will continue to super-clean everything and provide hand sanitizer. So don't let fear keep you from coming back to church. We miss you when you're not here.

October will also be the month we begin renovations to the church. The Property Committee has been busy. We have contracted the repainting of the church's outside, including the steeple. Financially Highland is sound. Our offerings are still twenty-percent lower than we budgeted, but our expenses have been about thirty-four-percent lower than budgeted. God has blessed us with a lower operating cost so we could continue his ministry work and refurbish His house at the same time.

As Brother Eric takes us through Nehemiah, keep praying for your staff and committees to be good stewards of God's funds and that we will lead and serve with God's will in refurbishing the church outside and the people inside. Nehemiah didn't plan to build the wall with hope. He knew that if he did what God told him to do, it would get done despite all obstacles. So he planned with God's guidance and went about his work with confidence from his faith. We can do that too. Confidence in God's provision will get the job done.
