Use it when you have out-of-town business to attend to, will be off your feet due to a medical procedure, or just need some time away to catch your breath.

- Participant must be 60 or older and have a dementia diagnosis
- Must have a family/informal caregiver
- Either the participant or caregiver must reside in Washtenaw County
- No financial eligibility requirements
- Subject to bed and funding availability
