

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, unfortunately, Second will not be able to house men from the Shelter Association of Washtenaw County (SAWC) rotating shelter program as we have in years past.

As we begin to embark upon another cold Michigan winter, Second can still be a big part of helping those in our community who are experiencing homelessness during this difficult time. The first way is to make a monetary donation through SBC to the SAWC Rotating Shelter Program. Whatever you can give or do will help make life a little easier and support those who are hosting this year.
