ASSESS

2. Where do you most frequently see the conflict between the persuasiveness of the enemy and God's best for you in your life?
3. The gospel is powerful. In what ways, specifically, do you cling to the Truth daily? Why is this important?
4. What Spiritual battles do you typically struggle with? What ways do you, or can you, prepare for these battles in advance?

APPLY

When we live in the beauty of the gospel, God is glorified, and our hearts are encouraged. What is one step you can take this week to live in the beauty of the gospel?

1. Share one way, specifically, that you will cling to the Truth this week.
2. Consider the Spiritual battles you struggle with. What is one way you can prepare in advance to have victory over that battle?
3. Who in your life needs to hear the beauty of the gospel? Commit to sharing the gospel with that person this week.
