1. Do you recall the first time you participated in Communion? Talk about that experience, your memories, etc.
2. Though based on the Passover Sedar(s), The Lord's Supper shifted the historic significance from the Exodus to Jesus' work on the cross. Why is it important to understand the Passover in order to appreciate Communion?
3. At GMC, we value togetherness. Communion is a moment to unite around our commonality in Christ. What are some ways you could leverage Communion to help your spouse, family or friends look more like Jesus?

Read- 1 Corinthians 11:27-32

4. Paul is clear that personal preparation for Communion is important. How does our personal life and communal life in Christ intersect?

5. As a group, discuss how Communion could play a part in your meeting times together in the future. Set a date and make plans to observe communion as a small group in 2020.
