## We're Learning in 2020

You haven't "Learned Your Lesson" until you <u>CHANGE</u> your <u>BEHAVIOR</u>.

#### 1. Be <u>READY</u> because the storms are coming.

John 16:33 - Jesus said, "In this world you will have troubles, but take heart because I have already overcome the world."

Matthew 7:24-27 - Jesus said, "Anyone who listens to my teaching and follows it is wise, like a person who builds a house on solid rock. Though the rain comes in torrents and the floodwaters rise and the winds beat against that house, it won't collapse because it is built on bedrock. But anyone who hears my teaching and doesn't obey it is foolish, like a person who builds a house on sand. When the rains and floods come and the winds beat against that house, it will collapse with a mighty crash."

I John 4:4 - Greater is the Spirit that is in you than the spirit that is in the world.

#### 2. Be **INTENTIONAL** because relationships matter.

### 3. Be THOUGHTFUL because your days are numbered.

Ephesians 5:15-17 - So be careful how you live. Don't live like fools, but like those who are wise. Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days. Don't act thoughtlessly, but understand what the Lord wants you to do.
