Romans 1

²⁰ For ever since the world was created, people have seen the earth and sky. Through everything God made, they can clearly see his invisible qualities - his eternal power and divine nature. So they have no excuse for not knowing God. ²¹ Yes, they knew God, but they wouldn't worship him as God or even give him thanks. ²⁵ They traded the truth about God for a lie. So they worshiped and served the things God created instead of the Creator himself, who is worthy of eternal praise! Amen!

Deuteronomy 4

²⁹ If you search for God with all your heart and soul, you will find him. ³¹ For the Lord your God is a merciful God; He will not abandon you or destroy you or forget the solemn covenant he made with your ancestors. ³² Now search all of history, from the time God created people on the earth until now and search from one end of the heavens to the other. Has anything as great as this ever been seen or heard before? ³³ Has any nation ever heard the voice of God speaking from fire - as you did - and survived? ³⁴ Has any other god dared to take a nation for himself out of another nation by means of trials, miraculous signs, wonders, war, a strong hand, a powerful arm, and terrifying acts? Yet that is what the Lord your God did for you in Egypt, right before your eyes. ³⁵ He showed you these things so you would know that the Lord is God and there is no other. ³⁶ He let you hear his voice from heaven so he could instruct you.

Isaiah 44

²⁴ This is what the Lord says - your Redeemer and Creator: "I am the Lord, who made all things. I alone stretched out the heavens. ²¹ I the Lord, made you, and I will not forget you. ²² I have swept away your sins like a cloud. I have scattered your offenses like the morning mists. ***Oh, return to me, for I have paid the price to set you free.***"
