*"I am blessed to **BLESS OTHERS.**"*

Genesis

5:1 When God created mankind, he made them to be like himself. ² He created them male and female, and blessed them and called their name "**Adam.**"

Bless Others by KNOWING your GIFTS.

Psalms 139:14 - "Thank you for making me so wonderfully complex! Your workmanship is marvelous - how well I know it."

Truth : Blessed isn't something you **HAVE**
it's something you **ARE.**

Q : What are your top 3 God given gifts -
and how are you making them better?

1:28 Then **God blessed them** and said,
"Be **fruitful** and **multiply**. **Fill the earth** and **rule it**.
Reign over the fish in the sea, the birds in the sky,
and all the animals that scurry along the ground."

- **fruitful** : *parah* - "to increase, to grow, to produce"
- **multiply** : *rabah* - "to increase, to excel, to be great"
- **fill** : *male'* - "to satisfy, to accomplish, to finish"
- **rule** : *kabash* - "to subdue, to conquer, to tread on"
- **reign** : *radah* - "to have dominion, to rule over"

1:29 Then God said, "**Look!** I have given you every seed-bearing plant throughout the earth and all the fruit trees for your food."

Bless Others by USING your GIFTS.

Romans 12:6 - "God has given each of us different gifts for doing certain things well."

Truth : Using your gift isn't PRIDE - it's PURPOSE.

**Q : What will you do today
that others will be glad you did?**

1:31 And evening passed and morning came, marking the **sixth day**. Then God looked over all he had made, and he saw that it was *very good*!

2:1 So the creation of the heavens and the earth and everything in them was completed. ² On the seventh day God had finished his work of creation, so he rested (*ceased*) from all his work.

2:3 And **God blessed the seventh day** and declared it holy, because it was the day when he rested from all his work of creation.

Bless Others by RESTING your GIFTS.

Genesis 12:2 - "I will bless you and you will be a blessing to others." (*God's promise to Abraham*)

Truth : God is doing something IN you so he can do something TROUGH you.

**Q : What is God doing in you that
will become a blessing to others?**

Questions and Actions.

Q : What are your **top 3 God-given gifts** and skills and how are you making them better?

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Q : What will you **do today** that others will be glad you did?

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Q : What is God doing in you that **will become** a blessing to others?

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Prayer : “Thank you for blessing me. I’m often tempted to compare and complain if things aren’t going my way. I look forward to not only **seeing** your daily blessings but **being a blessing** to those around me.”
