The MOST IMPORTANT thing you can do as a Man of God is to <u>SHARE</u> your <u>FAITH</u>.

5 Steps to Sharing Your Faith.

1. SEE the need.

Matthew 9 (NLT)

³⁶ When Jesus saw the crowds, he had compassion on them because they were confused and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.

John 1 (NLT)

³⁸ Jesus looked around and saw them following. "What do you want?" He asked them. They replied, "Rabbi" (which means Teacher), where are you staying?" ⁴⁰ "Come and see," he said. It was four o'clock in the afternoon when they went to the place where he was staying, and they remained with him the rest of the day.

Sharing your FAITH starts with <u>SEEING</u> the need.

2. <u>LISTEN</u> to their story.

Luke 19 (NLT)

⁵ When Jesus came by, he looked up at Zacchaeus and called him by name. "Zacchaeus!" He said. "Quick, come down! I must be a guest in your home today."

Nobody <u>CARES</u> what you have to say until they know you <u>CARE</u> about them.

John 3 (NLT)

²² Then Jesus and his disciples left Jerusalem and went into the Judean countryside. Jesus spent some time with them there, baptizing people.

3. OFFER to help.

Matthew 5 (NLT)

¹⁶ Jesus said, "Let your GOOD DEEDS shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father."

Romans 12 (NLT)

⁶ God has given each of us the ability to do certain things well.

Use your <u>DIFFERENCE</u> to make a <u>DIFFERENCE</u>.

Mark 1 (NLT)

15 Jesus said, "The Kingdom of God is **NEAR**!"

4. TELL them your story.

Psalm 107 (NIV)

² Let the redeemed of the Lord tell their story.

1 Peter 3 (NLT)

Worship Christ as the Lord of your Life. And if someone asks about your Christian hope, always be ready to explain it.
But do this in a gentle and respectful way.

Your <u>TESTIMONY</u> is the loudest <u>MESSAGE</u> you'll ever preach.

Mark 16 (NLT)

¹⁵ Jesus told his disciples, "GO into all the world and preach the GOOD NEWS to everyone."

John 1 (NLT): Andrew Brings Peter to Jesus

- ⁴⁰ Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, was one of these men who heard what John said and then followed Jesus.
- ⁴¹ Andrew went to find his brother, Simon, and told him, "We have found the Messiah." (which means "Christ")

John 4 (NLT): The Woman at the Well

²⁹ "Come and see a man who told me everything I ever did! Could this possibly be the Messiah?" ³⁰ So the people came streaming from the village to see him.

John 9 (NLT): The Man Born Blind

²⁴ So for the second time they [Pharisees] called in the man who had been blind and told him, "God should get the glory for this, because we know this man Jesus is a sinner."

²⁵ "I don't know whether he is a sinner," the man replied. "But I know this: *I was blind, and now I can see*!"

5. See what GOD does.

1 Corinthians 3 (NLT)

^{5b} Each of us did the work the Lord gave us. ⁶ I planted the seed in your hearts, and Apollos watered it, but it was God who made it grow. ⁷ It's not important who does the planting, or who does the watering. What's important is that God makes the seed grow. ⁸ The one who plants and the one who waters work together with the same purpose. And both will be rewarded for their own hard work. ^{9a} For we are both God's workers.
