Romans 3 (NLT)

¹⁰ **No one** is righteous - not even one. ²⁰ **No one** can ever be made right with God by doing what the law commands. The law simply shows us how sinful we are.

²¹ ***But now God has shown us a way to be made right with him without keeping the requirements of the law.***

²² We are made right with God by placing our faith in Jesus Christ. And this is true for **everyone** who believes, no matter who we are. ²³ For **everyone** has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard.

²⁴ Yet God, with undeserved kindness, declares that we are righteous. He did this through Christ Jesus when he freed us from the penalty of sins. ²⁵ For God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for our sin.

People are made right with God when they believe that Jesus sacrificed his life, shedding his blood.

²⁶ God did this to demonstrate his righteousness, for he himself is fair and just, and he declares sinners to be right in his sight when they believe in Jesus.

²⁷ Our acquittal is not based on obeying the law. It is based on **faith**.
