

### BECAUSE OF YOU, REFUGEES ARE EXPERIENCING JESUS' LOVE

A year ago, Nabil fled his war-torn country of Yemen to Jordan, where he couldn't get a job because of strict Jordanian employment laws. Unemployed and with two children to feed, Nabil was desperate.

Jake, an Alliance worker you sent, connected with Nabil through the Nabil's situation, Jake began paying him monthly to clean his language center. Then Nabil's son got appendicitis; the hospital would not operate unless the surgery was paid for up front. Jake and other Alliance workers quickly raised the funds for the emergency operation.

Nabil told Jake, "You Christians have shown me a love I have never experienced before. How do I get that same kind of love?"

Jake has since invited Nabil and another friend to his home weekly for dinner, coffee, and Bible study. A year ago, Nabil had many doubts and questions about the Bible and Christianity. Now he studies the Bible and is drawn to Jesus, especially after He recently appeared to Nabil in a dream!

Series: From the Ashes: Embracing the Full Life of God

**Topic: Humility** 

Speaker: Pastor Joe Ong

#### **Synopsis:**

Our lives can sometimes feel like a pile of ashes. Broken, shattered and destroyed! Good news – Jesus' life, death and resurrection gives us new life and has raised us from the ashes. During these 6 weeks, for new or seasoned believers, we want to grow in our faith and understanding learning from Jesus our Lord and Savior.

**Scripture:** Philippians 2:1-11

So if there is any encouragement in Christ, any comfort from love, any participation in the Spirit, any affection and sympathy, complete my joy by being of the same mind, having the same love, being in full accord and of one mind. Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Therefore God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
