

Pastor Mike's Memo



Fear or Faith

Before I began to write this article I checked my email. There I read a plea for prayer and support for a young man who is being charged with felonies for exposing the selling of baby parts by Planned Parenthood. How frustrating. Another article showed a street advertisement in Canada encouraging parents to have only one baby. What is it about babies that makes people so afraid?

Then I read an article about acts of genocide by jihadist rebels committed to ISIS, killing Christians in Mozambique. How sad. What is it about Christians that has these men so afraid of them, that they hate them and are trying to wipe them out?

The next article was about the fight for the Supreme Court appointee and the smear campaign against her, ignoring her excellent record of jurist prudence. Resorting to name calling and false narratives, her opposition sounded like adolescents. Her greatest flaw, she is a mother of seven and prolife. Why are people so afraid of a person committed to not adding interpretation to the law, and is a strong supporter of life from the womb to the tomb?

In the name of "liberty and freedom" people stand against life, religious freedom, and absolute truth. What they are really fighting for is to be able to define their own truth, live life their way, and not be held accountable. It is a denial of being held accountable for sin. In fear they run from the reality of, and faith in, God.

October is a transition month. Halloween candy and decorations compete with early Christmas merchandise. Highlighting darkness, evil and the horrific, is promoted as normal and fun. Fear and fright are welcomed with open arms. In dollars spent Halloween is the #2 celebration event. Be an unprotected baby in the womb, or a Christian in Mozambique, Nigeria, Sudan, Pakistan, Iran, or China, or have you name submitted to the Supreme Court, and fear and death are no laughing matter.

As followers of Christ we are called to walk in faith in God, live righteously, and be light to the world. Agape love, kindness, and forgiveness are to characterize us, and good news that gives hope through salvation in Jesus Christ is to be our message.

When all we read is bad news, we are to be good news! I am glad that we are a people who Love Like Jesus, by loving to one another and our neighbors. That is what a life of faith looks like. When the world around us is focused on fear and against faith in God, we need to "Keep the Faith" and be Good News.

COVID19 Update Requirements

The results of a recent court case against the restrictions given to churches has reduced requirements for churches with attendance under 250. The threat of shutting churches down for non-compliance has been removed. It is now up to the individuals who attend.

Masks are still mandated under the Governor's Executive Order 63 for all individuals participating in groups. Safety through safe practices is now each individual's responsibility. A word of wisdom: "I have the right to do anything," you say—but not everything is beneficial. "I have the right to do anything"—but not everything is constructive. 1Corinthians 10:23

What does this mean for Newington Baptist Church?

Apart from the required masks, we can set our standards. They will look familiar.

Love Like Jesus will continue to guide our attitude toward every attendee. Not self- centeredness but love for our neighbor.

Mask Use Required - because of the size of our gatherings.

Continued cleaning and sanitizing - of the building.

Hand Sanitizers – Dispensers are permanently placed on the walls for your use near our main entrances and outside of the restrooms. Hand washing still recommended.

Safety Distancing - To show respect to those who are present and are at "higher risk." To give them assurance they can safely attend.

Minimized Physical Contact – Continuing to refrain from encouraging or insisting on handshakes and hugs at this time. It is also now flu season.

Every Other Pew Seating - Bows on the end of each pew indicates the correct pew for use. Families continue to sit together. We ask for the practice of safety distancing for others.

Food Service – All food will be prepared and served by people with masks and gloves. No covered dish or self-service at this time.

On Campus and Online Worship continues.

It is up to each attendee to Love Like Jesus.

Even though the local numbers are down, we do not want an outbreak at Newington simply because we ignored good hygiene or didn't practiced safe fellowship. We are grateful that we can meet in person for worship, fellowship and Bible study, and do not want to jeopardize our gatherings. Praise God for faithful members and new guests who are attending.

Continue to **Pray** for families who have been affected, and for the end of this virus outbreak.


