It's winter and time to hunker down with a good book and a cup of something hot to drink! Our first highlighted book is a true story written by Dr. Mary Broeckert, MD, whom many of you know. She grew up in Allendale and is a sister to several in our church. *Present and Powerful: A Testimony of God's Working in Medical Missions* is the inspiring and fascinating story of serving the Lord as an overseas missionary doctor. When Mary was a young girl, she prayed that God would guide her life to accomplish whatever He desired, for His glory. That prayer of surrender took Dr. Mary on a journey of a lifetime! It was a fascinating and encouraging book for me personally to read, see and be reminded how great our God is and how miraculously He works...even in those times of struggle. It has encouraged this reader to realize how God is working even now, in whatever our situation to work for His glory and to bring people to Himself.

<u>Under the Tulip Tree</u> by Michelle Shocklee is a historical fiction novel set in the time of the Great Depression. Rena Leland accepts a position with the Federal Writers' Project interviewing former slaves. She is fascinated by 101-year-old Frankie Washington's account of her life, and the two begin to bond despite differences in age, race, and backgrounds. But when a surprising piece of news comes to light, will their friendship survive? This book was a 2021 Christy Award and Selah Award finalist.

<u>A Stranger's Game</u> is the new novel by Colleen Coble. Desperate for answers about her best friend's drowning death, wealthy hotel heiress Torie goes undercover on Jekyll Island. When she meets Joe rescuing turtles, she finds a tentative ally in her quest. The more they dig, the more truth eludes them. One thing is clear: someone will risk anything---including committing another murder---to keep secrets buried! Those familiar with Colleen will not be disappointed in this fast - moving tale with its twists and turns that will keep you reading way past your bedtime.

<u>The Secret Keepers of the Old Depot Grocery</u> by Amanda Cox. After suffering a traumatic experience, Sarah returns home to run her family's grocery alongside her mom, Rosemary, and grandmother, Glory Ann. Rosemary is determined to prevent Sarah from following in her footsteps and running the store. Plotting with Sarah to keep the store, Glory Ann is hiding an explosive decades-old secret. This dual time thought provoking story explores the complexity of mother-daughter relationships, the way the secrets we keep shape our lives and the lives of others and the healing power of telling the truth.

Recently added to our library are books one and two of The Nikki Boyd Files series by Lisa Harris. These fast-paced mysteries are titled, *Vendetta* (book 1) and *Missing* (book 2). Book three will be available in our library next month.
